



Jumping Washcloths

In Mark 12:31, Jesus says to “love your neighbor as yourself.” That means we are responsible for caring for people in our community as much as we care for ourselves. Go with a parent to drop off your jackrabbit at a local homeless shelter, where it can help a person who needs it. When we take on the responsibility to help others, it gives God joy and we get to share in that joy!



You'll Need

- 1 washcloth
- 1 fabric marker (optional)
- 2 rubber bands
- 2 clothespins (optional)
- 1 travel-size bar of soap

1. Lay the washcloth flat.
2. Fold one corner of the washcloth to the opposite corner.
3. Roll the folded washcloth.
4. Fold the roll in half and pinch the ends together.
5. Place the rubber bands around the washcloth to make the head of the rabbit. Place the first rubber band about halfway down the washcloth and the second one about one-quarter of the way down.
6. If you'd like, use fabric markers to draw a face on the rabbit's head.
7. Take the travel-size bar of soap out of its package, and place it in the loop of the rabbit's body.
8. You can add two clothespins to the bottom of the rabbit's body to make its feet.
